



CONDITIONAL SENTENCES

1	GENERAL CONDITIONAL (IF Simple Present + Simple Present) It goes without saying. / Es de cajón.	
	If it rains, we get wet. If you've got the flu, (you must/should) go to the doctor's.	Si llueve, nos mojamos. Si tienes la gripe, (debes/deberías) ir al médico.
2	POSSIBLE / PROBABLE CONDITIONAL (IF Simple Present + Simple Future) (The) chances are it rains. / Lo más probable es que llueva.	
	If it rains, we will stay home.	Si llueve, nos quedaremos en casa.
3	HYPOTHETICAL CONDITIONAL (IF Simple Past+ Simple Conditional) There is little chance that it rains. / Hay pocas probabilidades de que llueva.	
	If it rained, we would not go to the beach.	Si lloviera, no nos iríamos a la playa.
4	IMPOSSIBLE CONDITIONAL 1 (IF Past Perfect + Perfect Conditional) It never actually rained. / Nunca llegó a llover.	
	If it had rained, we would have gotten wet.	Si hubiera llovido, nos habríamos empapado.
	<u>If only</u> it had rained... I wish it had rained.	(¡Ay...!) ¡Si hubiera llovido...! Ojalá hubiera llovido.
	<u>EMPHATIC:</u> Had it rained, we would have gotten wet.	De haber llovido, nos habríamos empapado.
