- **1st.-** Aspect: Obligation, Advice/Logical expectation/Desirability/Moral Obligation (deber); Capacity, Probability (poder).
- **2nd.- Time:** Present, Past, Future.
- **3rd.-** <u>Verb Tense:</u> Perfect Conditional, Simple Past, Simple Present, Simple Future, Simple Conditional
- **4th.-** Meaning: deber (debe, debería, debió...)
