- **1st.-** <u>Aspect:</u> Capacity, Probability (**poder**); Obligation, Advice/Logical expectation/Desirability/Moral Obligation (**deber**).
- 2nd.- <u>Time:</u> Present, Past, Future.
- **3rd.-** <u>Verb Tense:</u> Perfect Conditional, Simple Past, Simple Present, Simple Future, Simple Conditional
- 4th.- <u>Meaning:</u> puede, pudo, podría, puede que...
