1	SUBJECT PRONOUNS	
<p>I (Yo)</p> <p>You: <u>You</u> know it. (<i>Tú lo sabes.</i>)</p> <p>He / She / It (Él / Ella / <i>generally not translated</i>)</p>	<p>We: <u>We</u> believe you. (<i>Nosotros te creemos.</i>)</p> <p>You (Vosotros-as; Usted-es)</p> <p>They (Ellos-as)</p>	
2	OBJECT PRONOUNS	
<p>Me (me)</p> <p>You (te)</p> <p>Him / her / it: Did you see <u>her</u>? (<i>¿Le viste?</i>)</p>	<p>Us: It belongs to <u>us</u>. (<i>Nos pertenece.</i>)</p> <p>You (os; le -de usted)</p> <p>Them (les)</p>	
3	POSSESSIVE PRONOUNS	
<p>Mine: A friend of <u>mine</u>. (<i>Un amigo mío.</i>)</p> <p>Yours (tuyo)</p> <p>His / hers / its (suyo)</p>	<p>Ours (nuestro)</p> <p>Yours: It's <u>yours</u>. (<i>Es vuestro; suyo -de usted</i>)</p> <p>Theirs (suyo)</p>	
4	REFLEXIVE PRONOUNS	
<p>Myself (yo mismo-a / yo solo, me)</p> <p>Yourself (Help <u>yourself</u>. (<i>Sírvete tú mismo/a.</i>))</p> <p>Himself / herself / itself (él mismo-ella misma / solo, se)</p>	<p>Ourselves (nosotros mismos / solos, nos)</p> <p>Yourselves (vosotros mismos / solos, os)</p> <p>Themselves: They did it <u>themselves</u>. (<i>Ellos solos OR mismos lo hicieron.</i>)</p>	
5	IMPERSONAL PRONOUNS (people in general)	
<p>One should enjoy oneself. (<u>Uno</u> debería pasarlo bien. / <i>Habría que pasarlo bien.</i>)</p>	<p>They never tell you the truth. (<i>Nunca le dicen la verdad a uno. / Nunca te dicen la verdad.</i>)</p>	
6	INDEFINITE (NON-SPECIFIC) PRONOUNS	
<p>Somebody / someone: alguien</p> <p>Something: algo; Some: algo* (de)</p> <p>Use: affirmative, and also interrogative when an affirmative answer is expected</p>	<p>Somebody is coming. / <i>Viene alguien.</i></p> <p>Someone will find it. / <i>Alguien lo encontrará.</i></p> <p>Something is wrong. / <i>Algo pasa.</i></p> <p>Would you like some? / <i>¿Quieres (algo*)?</i></p>	
<p>Anybody / Anyone: alguien, nadie (negative & interrogative), cualquier(a) (affirmative)</p> <p>Anything: algo (interrogative), nada (negative)</p>	<p>Anybody would know. / <i>Cualquiera lo sabría.</i></p> <p>Anyone else? / <i>¿Alguien más?</i></p> <p>Anything else? / <i>¿Algo más?</i></p>	
<p>Nobody / no one: nadie</p> <p>Nothing: nada</p> <p>Use: negative with emphasis</p>	<p>Nobody believes you. / <i>Nadie te cree.</i></p> <p>No one has it. / <i>Nadie lo tiene.</i></p> <p>Nothing matters. / <i>Nada importa.</i></p>	
<p>Every: todos, cada uno</p>	<p>Everybody knows. / <i>Todos lo saben.</i></p> <p>Everyone knows. / <i>Todos (emphatic) lo saben.</i></p> <p>Everything is here. / <i>Todo está aquí.</i></p>
