CONTRACTION	EQUIVALENT	EXAMPLE
A	COULD HAVE	You coulda signed an autograph for Matthew. –EMINEM- (Podrías haberle firmado un autógrafo a Matthew.)
	HAVE	You must- a got 'em. (Las habrás recibido.)
	SHOULD HAVE	I shoulda learned to play the guitar. –Dire Straits- (Debería haber aprendido a tocar la guitarra.)
	WOULD HAVE	I woulda known. (Lo habría sabido.)
AIN'T	AM NOT	I ain't gonna do it. (Yo no voy a hacerlo.)
	IS NOT	That ain't working. –Dire Straits- (Eso no funciona.)
	ARE NOT	Them (those) guys ain't dumb. –Dire Straits- (Esos tipos/tíos no son tontos.)
	THERE IS NOT	Ain't no mountain high enough... –Telefónica's Commercial- (No hay montaña lo suficientemente alta...)
HAVEN'T GOT and others...!!	Ain't got no flowers... –Audi Commercial- (No tengo flores...)	
C'MON	COME ON	C'mon! Let's go! (¡Venga!. ¡Vamos!)
COULDA	COULD HAVE	You coulda signed an autograph for Matthew. –EMINEM- (Podrías haberle firmado un autógrafo a Matthew.)
DUNNO	DON'T KNOW	I dunno . (No sé.)
D'YOU	DO YOU	How d'you know? (¿Cómo lo sabes /te has enterado?)
'EM	THEM	You must not have got ' em . (No los habrás recibido.) Tell ' em . (Díselo -a ellos-.)
GIMME	GIVE ME	Gimme, gimme, gimme a man after midnight! –ABBA- (¡Dame, dame, dame un hombre después de la medianoche!)
GONNA	GOING TO	(I'm) Never gonna give you up. –Pet Shop Boys- (Nunca te voy a dejar/abandonar.)
GOTCHA!	I GOT YOU!	Gotcha! (Te pillé!)
GOTTA	GOT TO	I've gotta go. / I gotta go. (Me tengo que ir.)
HOW'YA	HOW ARE YOU	How'ya doing? (¿Cómo te va?)
I'MA	I AM GOING TO	If I have a daughter, guess what I'ma call her? I'ma name her Bonnie. –EMINEM- (Si tengo una hija, adivina cómo le voy a llamar. Le voy a llamar Bonnie.)
KINDA	KIND OF	That's kinda how this is. –EMINEM- (Así es más o menos.)
LEMME	LET ME	Lemme tell ya (you). –Dire Straits- (Déjame que te cuente/explique.)
LOTTA	LOT OF	A whole lotta people showed up. (Mucha gente asistió.)
MA'AM	MADAM	How can I help you, ma'am ? (En qué le puedo ayudar, señora ?)
MUSTA	MUST HAVE	I musta missed you. –EMINEM- (Debo haberte echado de menos.)
OUTTA	OUT OF	Get outta here! (¡Fuera de aquí!)
OUGHTA	OUGHT TO	I oughta go. (Me debo ir. –moral obligation-)
SHOULDA	SHOULD HAVE	I shoulda learned to play the guitar. –Dire Straits- (Debería haber aprendido a tocar la guitarra.)
WANNA	WANT TO	If you wanna be my lover..., you've got to be my friend. –Spice Girls- (Si quieres ser mi amante..., tienes que ser mi amigo.)
WOULDA	WOULD HAVE	I woulda known. (Lo habrá sabido.)
